1. Effective learning is more likely to occur when learners know what is expected of them.	Duration 5 minutes - Activities for Goal 1 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-course Survey: What is Brotherhood to you? • List 5 words from 5 diff. students to define <i>Brotherhood</i>.
2. Effective learning is likely to occur when learners are familiar with materials, equipment and processes in the learning endeavor.	Duration: 5 minutes - Listening Activities for Goal 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will receive song lyrics, listen to the audio track then learn the song in parts.
3. Learners' tangible commitment to learning increases the likelihood of student's persistence in completing the course.	Duration: 5 minutes - Activities for Goal 3 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will write out the song lyrics in their notebooks.
4. Constant practice and repetition with materials, equipment and processes increase the comfort level of those required to use them.	Duration: 10 minutes - Activities for Goal 4 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will stand and present the song, while listening to the song. • Students will stand and present the song acappella.
5. Student Reflection.	Duration: 10 minutes - Activities for Goal 5 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Small Group Discussion. • Ask students if this song has the ability to bring them closer as members of this program. • The importance of being able to count on your friends. • The importance of depending on each other. • The importance of one's word.
